With six weeks left until ADE 2023, Amsterdam Dance Event reveals its second wave of artists. Highlights include the electro organic sounds of jazz quartet ECHT!, **Jameszoo in Muziekgebouw**, a live performance by **Overmono**, a one-off concert by Mary Lake and Amsterdams Andalusisch Orkest, and many others.

Alongside the nighttime festival program, one of ADE's newest tracks - ADE Arts & Culture - is celebrating its third edition, focusing on a new generation of creators, electronic music's positive impact, and broadening horizons. The ADE Arts & Culture program ranges from interactive theater pieces such as Nicole Beutler's **ATMEN** at Internationaal Theater Amsterdam, to the interdisciplinary **Gay Guerilla** by 24classics at Zuiderkerk, to a film program at venues such as **Eye Filmmuseum**, Melkweg Cinema, Kriterion and more.
